# Atlanta Figure Skating Club Scholarship Application Requirements

#### **General Criteria**

The Atlanta Figure Skating Club academic scholarship program was developed to assist figure skaters and figure skating volunteers who are pursuing a college or university degree. Awards are based on academic performance and volunteer service participation in figure skating and/or the community.

#### Requirements

- Applicant must be a current U.S. Figure Skating/Atlanta Figure Skating Club member in good standing.
- The applicant must have been a full member of the Atlanta Figure Skating Club for a minimum of <a href="mailto:three">three</a> years, and the Atlanta FSC must be the applicant's home club.
- Applicant must be accepted, enrolled, and pursuing a degree at one of the following:
  - Accredited four-year college/university
  - Accredited junior or community college
  - Accredited graduate school
- Applicant must carry at least the minimum credit hours per semester to qualify as a full-time student
- Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale or 3.75 or higher on a 5.0 scale.
- High school seniors must submit a high school transcript with an official school seal including grade point average.
- Applicant must meet one of the following requirements:
  - Actively skating (competing or testing)
  - If a former skater/official, must demonstrate community and/or figure skating volunteer involvement

#### **Application Deadline**

This application must be completed and mailed to the Atlanta FSC Academic Scholarship Committee with a postmark of no later than the third Friday of April.

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## Atlanta Figure Skating Club Scholarship Application Instructions

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### Instructions

- Type or print the application legibly.
- Answer all questions completely. If a question does not pertain to you, enter "N/A."
- Sign and date the application.
- Mail the completed application with required records to the address on page 1.
- Direct any questions to the Academic Scholarship Committee by contacting the club president.

#### **Essay**

All applicants must submit an essay (typed, double-spaced) of 500 words or less.

#### Limitations

Scholarship awards are non-renewable. Applicants can qualify only once.

#### **Grant Budget**

Grants may not exceed the approved total budget of \$2,000, regardless of the number of applicants. The \$2,000 will be awarded in increments of either \$1,000 or \$500.

#### Award Notification/ Disbursement

All applicants will be notified by e-mail if they have qualified for a scholarship. <u>Awards</u> will be mailed directly to the designated university/college.

#### **Disclaimers**

Race, gender, religion and ethnic background are not considered in the selection of award recipients.

The selection of scholarship recipients is determined by the Atlanta Figure Skating Club Academic Scholarship Committee.

The continuation of the Atlanta Figure Skating Club Academic Scholarship program is dependent on income derived from membership dues, contributions, and competition profits. There is no guaranteed funding for athletes.
